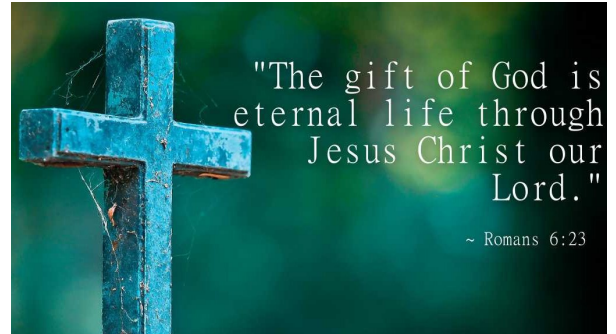

DO YOU WEAR A HEARING AID, BUT STILL CAN'T HEAR WELL DURING MASS ?

The parish is investigating a system that could enhance the ability of parishioners who wear hearing aids to hear the Mass better. Your hearing aid must have a **telecoil**, which we are told 80% of hearing aid models come with - you can confirm with your supplier if yours has this feature. Unfortunately, only the St. Kevin's church is a suitable candidate for this type of system.

Missionary Month - October 2023

“You shall love the Lord, your God and your neighbour as yourself.” (Mt 22:37–39)
We have reached the last Sunday of Missionary Month, under the theme: “Hearts on fire, feet on the move” (cf. Lk 24:13–35). For Pope Francis, “The urgency of the Church’s missionary activity naturally calls for an ever-closer missionary cooperation on the part of all her members and at every level. This is an essential goal of the synodal journey that the Church has undertaken, guided by the key words: communion, participation, mission.”

This journey is certainly not a turning of the Church in upon herself; nor is it a referendum about what we ought to believe and practise, nor a matter of human preferences. Rather, it is a process of setting out on the way and, like the disciples of Emmaus, listening to the risen Lord. For he always comes among us to explain the meaning of the Scriptures and to break bread for us, so that we can, by the power of the Holy Spirit, carry out his mission in the world”

The Other Side of Love

Dennis is one of the local street people who lives around the parish where I live. He is usually pleasant and courteous and wants to do things right, though he also struggles with his own set of demons. For the most part, Dennis seems to be finding his way through the mazes of life, as people do in their own fashion.

In some ways, the parishioners have become a family for Dennis, or at least a part of the family scattered about the neighborhood. Frequently he will be gone for a time, and we will wonder what happened to Dennis, only to find him drifting back among us.

These days Dennis is angry with us. For whatever reason, Dennis brought his assembled belongings and took up residence on our garage roof. The roof is flat and has a two-foot-high wall around the edge, a place that affords a bit of shelter from the wind. Soon, however, the parish came up with a list of reasons why it would be best if Dennis did not live on our garage roof—safety, security, and insurance among them. So Dennis was asked to move on, and that's why Dennis is angry with us.

The parish staff tries to be sensitive and caring about the street people. They try to let them make their own way when that is what they want to do. Yet at other times the staff needs to do what is best for everyone involved in the parish. It's not always easy to know how to love someone. ●
