ALPHA UPDATE

Imagine what it would be like if each one of us invited just one person that we already share life with to explore a relationship with Jesus and find new hope. If you want to invite a friend, family member or neighbour to church, to a small group or to Alpha, you may wonder, how you can actually connect with them effectively and respectfully.

In addition, on a more personal level, What if they say no? What if they ask questions that you're not prepared to answer? How will your invitation affect your relationship?

We know that the best invitations are rooted in relationships but for the next several weeks we will be offering practical tips for inviting people to Alpha. Here are two of those practical tips.

TIP #1: Stop before you start

Pause and pray. Ask God whom you should invite. We have the opportunity to collaborate with the Holy Spirit in the conversations that He is already having with the people around us. Utilize the 11:02 prayer card to commit to praying for three people you want to invite.

TIP #2: Customize the conversation

In the Bible, Jesus interacted with different people differently. There was no “one-size fits all” conversation. Consider what you know about the past experiences, hesitations, frustrations and hopes of the person you are going to invite. By taking the time to understand the individual, you increase the chance they will say yes to your invitation.
